





Brockwell Park, Summer Event Series 2021

WIDE AWAKE - Friday 3rd September 2021 MIGHTY HOOPLA – Saturday 4th September 2021 CROSS THE TRACKS – Sunday 5th September 2021

This letter will give you key information about the 2021 Summer Event Series in Brockwell Park. The series of events includes Wide Awake, Mighty Hoopla and Cross The Tracks. These events will be taking place in Brockwell Park on 3rd - 5th September 2021.

Below, we have outlined the steps we are taking to minimise the event's impact on local residents, and how to get in touch with us during the event period.

Event Set Up & Site Arrangements

Preparations for the event will begin on Tuesday 24th August and the dismantling of the event site is scheduled to be complete by Sunday 12th September, after which the organisers will hand the site back to the council. Prior to handing the site back we ensure that all remaining public spaces are clean and returned to the best possible standard.

A key pathway that allows a crossing point between the tennis courts and Brockwell Hall will still be accessible during the majority of this time from 8am-8pm, only closing for safety and security reasons on Wednesday 1st September – Monday 6th September.

Sound Management

As organisers, we are required to ensure that noise from the events is controlled to limits agreed with the local authority. A team of acoustic consultants monitor levels on both the Lambeth and Southwark side of the park.

The sound systems will be tested the day prior to the events taking place to ensure that they do not exceed the noise limits included within our premises licence. There will be a further brief period of testing on the morning of each event. Traffic

It has been agreed during the planning of the event to put in place temporary road closures on event days to enable the safe and controlled movement of large numbers of pedestrians towards public transport hubs. The following closures will be implemented over the three show days (Friday 3rd - Sunday 5th September):

For arriving audience - closures (estimated 1100 – 0000)

• Arlingford Road (at its junction with Brailsford Road)

• Railton Road (From junction with Rymer Street to junction with Dulwich Road)

For departing audience - closures (estimated 2030 – 0000)

• Morval Road (at its junction with Effra Road)

• Brixton Water Lane (at its junction with Dalberg Road & Effra Parade)

Norwood Road (at its junction with Croxted Road)

- Railton Road (at its junction with Regent Street)
- Dulwich Road (at its junction with Regent Road)
- Dulwich Road (at its junction with Rymer Street)

• Dulwich Road (at its junction with Half Moon Lane)

Resident Only Access

The following roads will have resident-only access during the egress phase (20:30 – 00:00). In order to get through these road closures, businesses and residents will need to show an original copy of this letter to the steward at the access point.

- Hurst Street
- Rymer Street
- Railton Road (from junction with Regent Road)
- Arlingford Road
- Trelawn Road

There will be parking restrictions on Effra Road, Morval Road, Brixton Water Lane, Dalberg Road, and Norwood Road. If you believe your vehicle has been removed please contact **TRACE** on **0300 077 0100**.

If any residents or businesses have any questions regarding vehicle access during the event road closures please get in touch with us using the contact details at the bottom of this leaflet.

Low Traffic Neighborhood

All LTN closures will remain in place, when road closures are in place for egress resident

vehicles will use the following routes to exit the area:

Regent Road, Milton Road, Shakespeare Road, Spenser Road, Chaucer Road, Effra Parade – will use Railton Road, Barnwell Road, Rattray Road, Kellet Road to exit onto Effra Road. Hurst Street & Rymer Road – will use Dulwich Road, Shakespeare Road, Barnwell Road, Rattray Road, Kellett Road to exit onto Effra Road.

Impact of the Event

The event organisers have worked extensively with the Lambeth Safety Advisory Group to ensure that the impact of the event on residents is minimised. A safe egress plan has been developed to manage the impact on the surrounding areas.

The egress plans include the cleaning and waste removal from the surrounding streets, temporary toilets positioned at key locations along the exit routes for the audience leaving the park each night and security deployment to manage anti-social behaviour. The event itself will be provided with adequate toilet facilities for the number of people that are likely to attend. During the event, the organisers will work closely with the police and other statutory bodies, meeting regularly to respond quickly and effectively to issues raised by residents.
