Building on five previous productions (held between 2015 and 2018), this inspiring production for all ages takes place with the audience travelling across London on bicycles. This would be an inclusive, community event for cyclists of all skills and ages. Participants would cycle along a safe, residential route coming across many sights and installations along the way including a stilt walker, drummers, a trick cyclist among other performers including a community chorus of 18-25 year olds. The ride would be accompanied by a celebratory spring soundscape. All dependent on government guidelines for performance, we are planning for 60 audience members, all on bikes, divided into 2 groups of 30, and accompanied by Cycle Stewards, from Cycle Confident, a training organisation whose aim is to unlock London by empowering everyone to cycle confidently and safely. They will also be accompanied stewards from Wheel's for Wellbeing, a Brixton based charity supporting disabled people of all ages and abilities to enjoy the benefits of cycling. If, at the end of March, the idea of a travelling performance on bicycles goes against government guidelines, we will mount the performance entirely in the Cockpond on Clapham Common, with the audience stationary, and where track and trace can more easily be implemented.
